

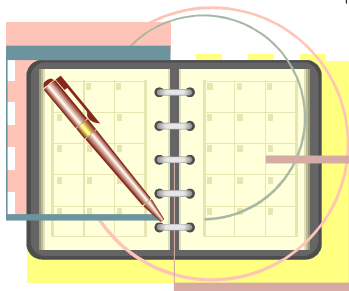

This review course will be taught in three segments (Individual, Business Entity and Ethics) over the course of four weekends.

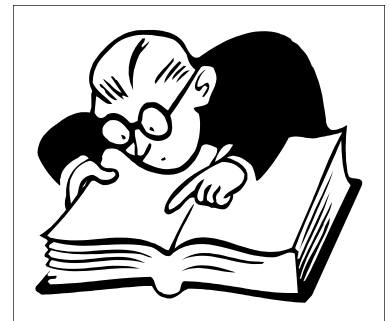

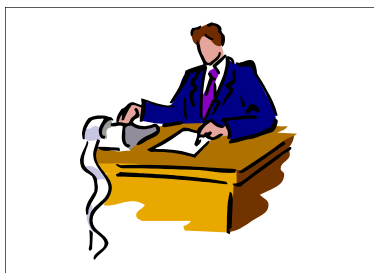

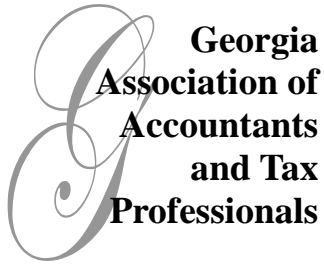
